Kym Teusner from Teusner Wines has come back to support the local area through the Murraylands Music Festival. Kym was bought up on a farm on the Karoonda Road, just out of Tailem Bend. He attended Tailem Bend Primary School and later went to Murray Bridge High School.

"My formative years at these schools gave me a solid foundation about learning and life".

To this end Kym has become a major sponsor for the Music Festival.

"I believe in the school's community spirit and providing its students and community with enterprising opportunities". Kym Teusner graduated from the University of Adelaide with a Bachelor of Science (Oenology Major) in 2001. He was focused upon returning to the Barossa and experimenting with Rhone varieties that grow so well there. Once finished his studies, this drive led him to work with several high profile producers of Rhone style wines whilst working on the launch of his own label.

Kym says "My philosophy is to produce only exceptional, affordable wines by being very selective about the fruit that we source from old, well maintained vineyards. These vineyards reliably produce balanced, complex fruit, which we guide, with minimal inputs, into wine. Our fruit sources are predominantly family and close friends, which allows us this selectivity in which fruit we vinify.

I still get a real lift when I read reviews about wines we have made and we are grateful that so many of them have been kind. More important is hearing from wine consumers who front up with hard earned cash, buy a bottle and return for another. That really keeps us going. Thus we are delighted that so much of our Joshua is now selling in New York. We hope it maintains its flavour of the month status.

The Barossa will finally come of age when all the grapes grown in the valley are marketed as Barossa wines. Few people realise that only about 30% of production ends up being called Barossa. Bit by bit small companies like Teusner will have an impact. Our philosophy is simple - work with grape growers who have low yielding blocks and encourage them to produce the best possible fruit. We believe very strongly in this and take back to our growers, wines made from their fruit and Mike suggests ways that the quality may be improved. Basically we encourage small bunches and low yields. No grower can do this unless they are paid more. But this is the only way to express the uniqueness of each vineyard site. If we have no relationship with the grower we do not have good wine as good wine is made primarily in the vineyard.

Kym is another success story from Tailem Bend and we are proud to have his company on board with us this year. Kym Teusner has produced a Barossa Shiraz Cabernet 2005 wine that retails at \$30.00 per bottle. The special festival price is \$20.00 per bottle or \$18.00 per bottle per dozen.

The school will sell the wine before and during the festival.  
Teusner wines will be on sale at the Music festival throughout the weekend.
